**IFA2 – Broom Way lane closure**

I am writing to update you on the work we will be doing in the area to create a new entrance to our site from Broom Way.

We expect to begin this work on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> June, and to finish within four weeks. During some of this time, we will need to temporarily close one lane to traffic on Broom Way. This is to allow us to connect the new entrance to our site to the existing road network. We will put in place temporary traffic lights with a full time operator to manage the single lane of traffic in this period.

To minimise the impact on the local community as far as possible, we have planned for these works to be carried out in such a way to reduce the duration the lane closure that will be needed to be in place. The period which the lane closure will be in place is currently anticipated to be off-peak hours (09.30am-15.30pm) for a five day period during the week of the 11<sup>th</sup> of June.

As part of these works we will also divert the footpath which runs along Broom Way. This will be clearly signposted. We have agreed all work in advance with both Hampshire County Council, which is the body responsible for managing roads in the local area and Fareham Borough Council.
